HOME Slough is about more people choosing, creating and taking part in brilliant art experiences in Slough.

Our programming is co-designed, co-commissioned and co-created with our Community Programming Board, an open group made up of Slough residents and creatives.

We are a Creative People and Places Programme funded by Arts Council England and Slough Borough Council. We started working in the town in 2015 and are currently funded until 2025.

There are over 30 Creative People and Places projects in England, located in areas where people have traditionally had fewer opportunities to get involved with the arts. Creative People and Places projects have reached over 1.2 million people, 90% of who do not regularly engage in the arts.

We are seeking motivated and passionate individuals to join our team as Arts & Culture Events Volunteers. As a volunteer, you will have the opportunity to help bring arts and culture events to the community and assist with the running of these events and projects.
